
Membership

- The Houston Book Club was formed in 1989, thirty-five years ago¹
- Seven current members:
 - Louis joined ~1991
 - John joined ~1993
 - Linda joined ~1994
 - Barbara joined ~1999
 - Jessica joined ~2001
 - Drew joined ~2001
 - Sylvia joined ~2004
- Modern Era (with present lineup) can be represented by the twenty-year period of 8/2004 through 8/2024
- Membership fluctuated between **five** and **seven** with additions of Andy (2002-2005) and Suzanne (2007/2008) and temporary sabbaticals by Drew, Jessica, and Sylvia. Rashid left mid-2004 just before the beginning of this period.

- There have been one hundred eighty-five meetings in the Modern Era, an average of roughly one meeting every thirtynine days
- Half of the eighteen complete years had nine meetings per year, followed by ten meetings per year five times, with two years having eleven meetings and two years having eight meetings.
 One year had only seven meetings, 2008.






- The longest time between meetings was one hundred thirtythree days at the onset of the pandemic in 2020, and the shortest was fourteen days, the very next meeting following our resumption

Topics (Modern Era)

- During this period, we've selected books from twenty-eight topics, one still
 ongoing (Pulitzer Prize for Fiction) and one finishing up at the start of this era
 (History of Science)
- One topic was selected two times (Scandinavian Authors)
- Topics have been:
 - Twelve geography-based (Australia, Eastern Europe, France, India, Mexico, Native American, Outer Space, Russia, Scandinavia [twice], Southern Writers, Texas)
 - Four fields of Study-based (History of Science, Music, Medicine, Exploration)
 - Three elements-based (The Sea, Fire, The Sky)
 - Three prize-based (Pulitzer, Edgar, Newbery)
 - Two War-based (WW1, WW2)
 - Two genre-based (Spy, Historical Fiction)
 - Two wildcard-based (Our Favorite Books, Member's Choice)
